Business Arising from Minutes

- a. iCampus Council- Update-Samantha
 - i. No updates at this time, waiting to hear back from original speaker, looking to find something low cost/free. Will require volunteers to set up tables, etc. when it's time to move ahead.
- b. Non-Fundraiser- Update
 - i. Scott: "helping hands fund" and donation button for hot lunch. no answer yet, reaching out to Division Office to see how we can make it fair for all families in need. Might be something to try to have in place for September. "More for Mustangs" as the catch phrase?
- c. Fundraising Committee-do we want to explore new fundraisers?
 - i. Last meeting demonstrated some enthusiasm for fundraising, is this the right time to take this on? Covid etc has hindered this. If we have the support, it would be nice to have flexibility to be able to support projects within the school.
 - ii. As we look ahead to fundraisers, we need to set the goal of 2 months notice to communicate within the school, to parents, to office, organize behind the scenes, etc.
 - iii. Right now is 2 months ahead to plan for something for Easter? At the elementary school, they buy enough that the school buys at least one for each student, teachers get a deal to purchase for their classes.
